

## College Requirements:

- First meet High School graduation requirements: Eagle County School District requires:  
  
25 credits. These should include:
- 3 Years of Math. Most Colleges require 4 years: (Pre-Algebra, Algebra, Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus or Dual Enrollment College Algebra, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC).
- 4 Years of English (English 9, World Literature, Composition, AP English Language and Composition)
- 2.5 Years of Social Studies: (World Geography, World History, United States History, Government)
- 3 Years of Lab Science. Many colleges strongly recommend 4 years: (Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
- .5 credit of Health
- 1.5 - Physical Education
- Foreign Language. Many colleges strongly recommend 3-4 years
- Scores for the ACT + Writing **OR** the SAT
- Take 2 SAT Subject Tests. Required by more selective schools
- Most California Universities strongly recommend 1 credit of Art or Dramatic Arts
